1. To implement the revised Outcome based syllabus for the B.Com programme from the academic year 2020-2021 onwards.
2. To make the following modifications in the existing course structure and content of the syllabus.

(i). Soft Skill I & II is introduced as skill enhancement courses I & II in IV& V Semester respectively.

(ii) Goods and Services Tax is introduced as Skill enhancement course III in V semester.

(iii) A Course titled, 'Insurance Management' is introduced as Elective Course in Semester V.

(iv) A course titled, 'Partnership Accounting' is introduced in Semester III as Core Course IV.

(v) A Core Course titled, 'Business Accounting' in Semester II is shifted to Semester III with necessary changes.










The Chairperson welcomed the members and outlined the Agenda of the meeting.

It is resolved that:

1. To implement the revised Outcome based syllabus for the M.Com programme from the academic year 2020-2021 onwards.
2. To make the following modifications in the existing course structure and content of the syllabus.
  - (i). The Course titled 'Advanced cost Accounting' in semester I is reframed and titled as 'Cost and Management Accounting'.
  - (ii). The Core course titled 'Quantitative Techniques for Business Decisions' in Semester VI is reframed.
  - (iii). The Course titled Research Methodology in Semester III is reframed.
  - (iv). The Core Course titled 'Financial services' in Semester I is replaced by 'Managerial Economics' and shifted to semester IV.
  - (v). The Core course titled 'Retail Marketing' in semester II is replaced by 'Goods and Services Tax' and shifted as Elective course in same semester.
  - (vi). The new course titled 'Customer Relation Management' is introduced as Elective course in semester III.
  - (vii). A practical components is included in the core course 'Organisational Behaviour' in the proportion of 60 percent Theory and 40 percent practical.
  - (viii). The Core course titled 'Computer Applications in Business' is changed as full practical paper.
  - (ix) Two Skill Enhancement Courses SPSS package I – Theory and SPSS package II – Practical are introduced in the I and II Semester.
  - (x) A course titled 'Women Entrepreneurial Development' can be introduced as extra disciplinary course for non-commerce students.
  - (xi) Self Study course II is also introduced with the title 'Commerce for Competitive Examinations' so as to enable students go through the competitive examinations.
  - (xii) It is suggested that 6 instruction hours and 2 credits may be allotted for project work instead of 12 hours and 6 credits. An additional core course with 6 hours and 4 credits may be introduced instead.
  - (xiii) The content of the syllabus is reframed in many courses.
3. Unit-6 is included for study and for reference for the students (not for evaluation) in all the courses.
4. The panel of recommended examiners is included.
