

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



## M.2 Preamble:

- Government College for Women (Autonomous), Kumbakonam is a Government educational Institution established by the Government. Its main objective is to cater to M.2.1. the higher educational needs of all, especially the poor, the needy and the underprivileged. Kumbakonam had to cater to the Women's Education hence there was a necessity to start a separate college to fulfill the ambition and the desire of a large number of women students. As there was no separate college for women throughout the district, the first mofussil college was started amidst a number of hurdles, in 1963, July, with pre-university courses. Being a 57 year old institution, the college is bestowed with a strong Alumni Association. It is a Registered Body. It is providing financial assistance for various activities of the college to ensure smooth administration. In honour of the first principal, who has been considered as the foundation stone of the institution, in her name Radha Memorial Day is celebrated by Old Student Association. Her tireless work and sacrifice to erect this Government institution is recognized by each individual including staff and students of the college. The college offers 12 UG, 11 PG, 4 M. Phil and 10 Ph. D. programmes. It was re accredited by NAAC with 'B'. The college celebrated its Golden Jubilee in 2016 and it is marching towards the Diamond Jubilee
  - M.2.2. Bon Secours College for Women is a Higher Educational Institution run by the Franciscan Sisters of Our Lady of Bon Secours. The College was started in the year 2002 with a meagre strength of 50 students. Now it has grown considerably with a total strength of the 4352 students. The College is situated near Vilar village in a sprawling area of 16 acres. The location of the college in a sylvan surrounding provides perfect atmosphere for learning. The college offers 18 UG, 12 PG, 5 M. Phil and 4 Ph. D. programmes. There are more than 191 Diploma/Certificate/Value Added/ Add on Courses offered in line with skill development and Entrepreneurship. On the hole Bon Secours extends its services towards the holistic development of the student community to transform them as Nation builders. The college, affiliated to Bharathidasan University is recognized by UGC under 2(f) and 12 (B) of UGC Act 1956 and is accredited with 'A++' Grade(CGPA3.71) by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) in Second Cycle, Bon Secours College is the only

college in Thanjavur among the self-finance colleges, to have achieved this credit. The college has been ranked by NIRF in the 151-200 Band and scoured first rank in Best money value category for Fashion Technology by India Today ranking for the year 2022, the college is recognized as the potential mentor for NAAC aspiring institutions under Paramarsh scheme.

- M.2.3 In 1965 B.A. History was introduced. From that year onwards "The Department of History" occupied a prime position in the growth of the college as the number of student admitted in the department increased year by year. As per the Government order the college introduced Tamil as parallel medium of instruction during the academic year 1967-1968. In 2005 PG course was started. In the year 2007, shift 2 was started to fulfill the increased demand for the course and at UG Level. Research programme was initiated during the academic year 2017-2018 onwards.
- M.2.4 The Department of History started in 2014 is interdisciplinary in nature and combines the understanding of areas such as political, religious, social, economic, culture, law, human resource development and tourism. The curriculum introduces students to historical methodology and the fundamentals of historical research and writing. The department of History aims to make the students aware of the past so its legacies through teaching, research and extension activities in context of Indian and world history. The department has been taking initiatives to build the knowledge about interconnections between global, National, reginal & local history through various teaching learning methodologies like visit to Archaeological & Historical sites, Clay modeling, Palm leaf manuscript, Thanjavur doll making and temple studies etc. The department maintains Heritage Hut where the historical foot prints have been conserved for the inheritance of history through ancient painting, stamps, coins, monuments etc.
- M.2.5 Whereas both GCW(A)K and BSCWT are convinced about the mutual benefit of forgoing formal linkage to develop new collaborative teaching and research programs in the pioneering areas of History. 
