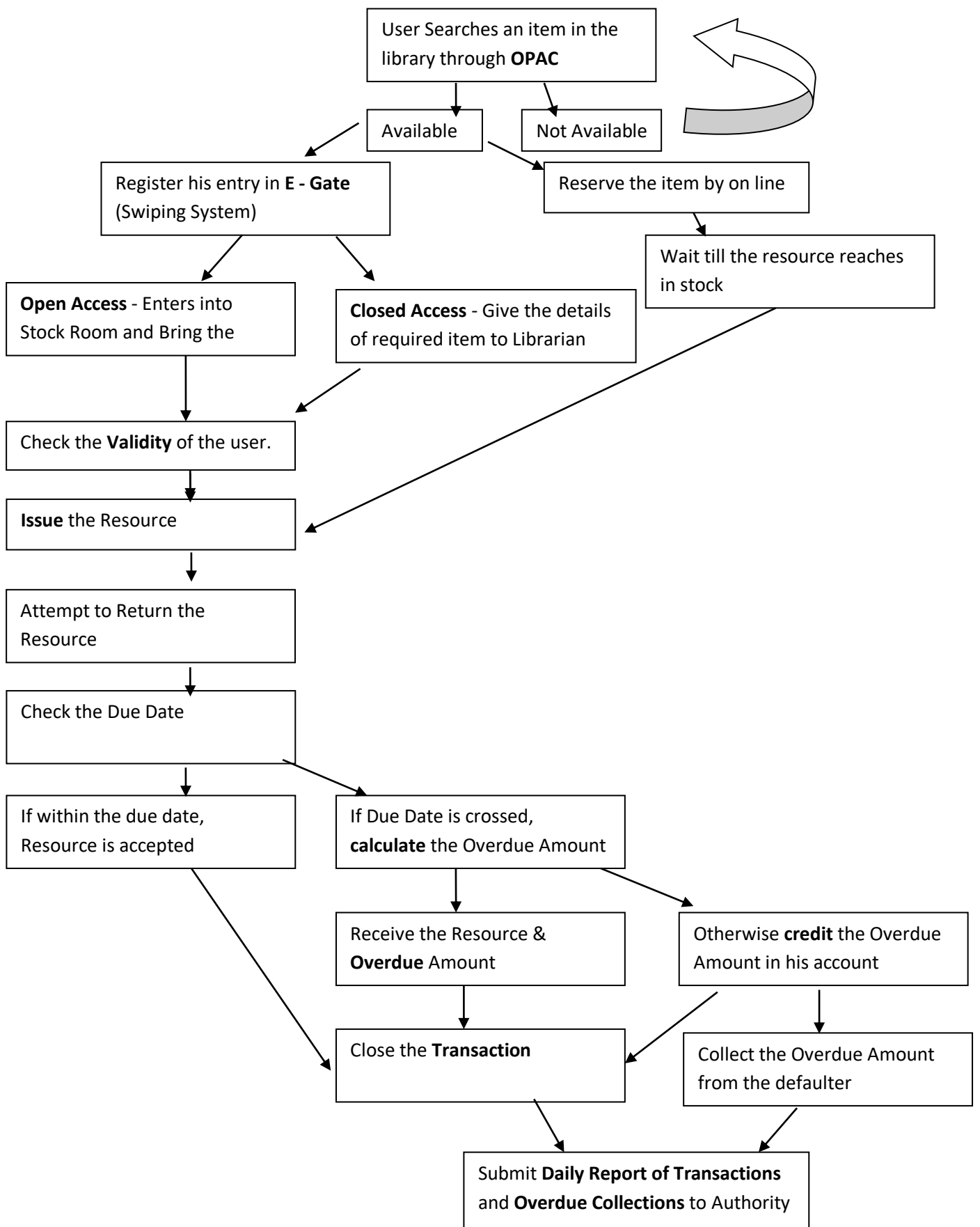

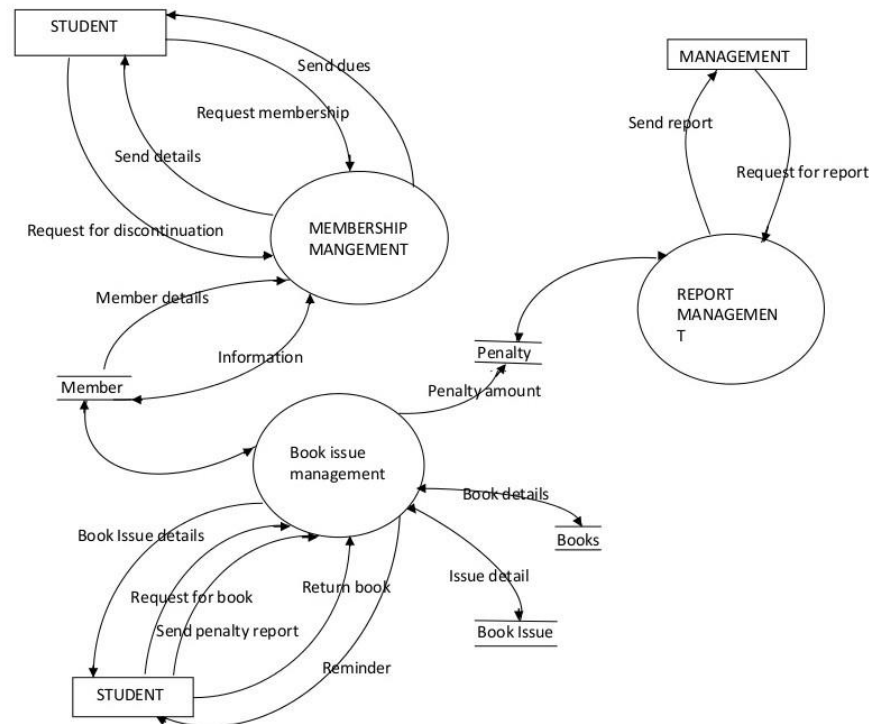

The details of accommodating information in the digital library are as follow:

1. E - Books. The books available in the net or collections of E - books in the form of PDF can be uploaded through the software. The Librarian can catalogue them with **Title, Author, Publisher** with **Content Page, Cover Page and Full Book** and ensure them the records uploaded are useful and present them in a perfect way. Provision for edit / update facilities available and the authority can do whenever they are necessary.

2. E - Journals. The journals you have downloaded from the valid gateway can be reprocessed and stored in the Digital Library Software and the same is available in **search. Articles and clippings** can be recorded.

3. Images. Any function / event that photographed / video covered shall be stored properly in the path and this is made available for the users to view and get information / download audio / video clippings. With keywords, the information with clippings shall be retrieved

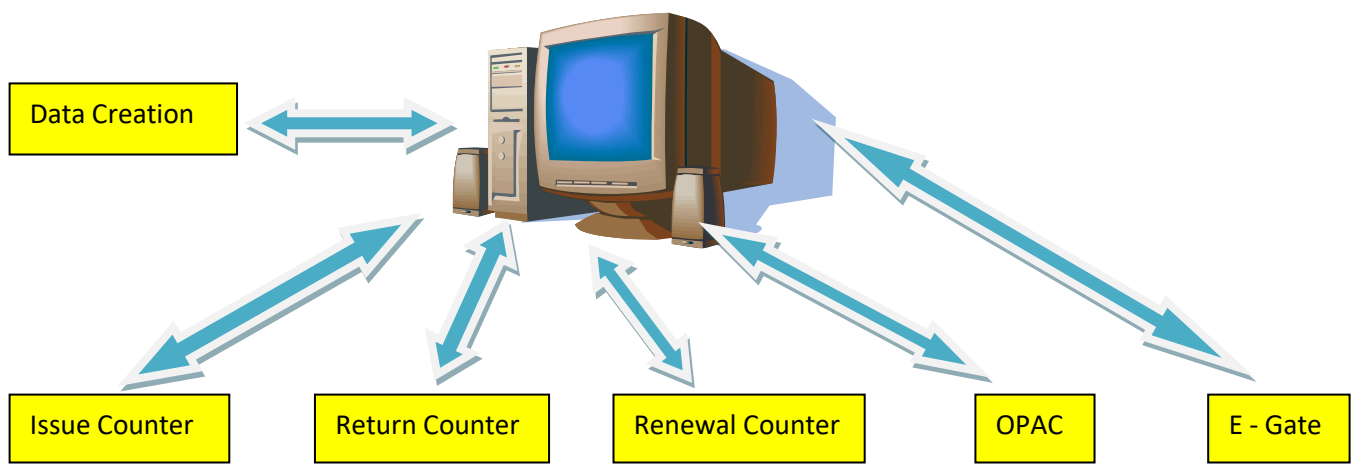
