5.1.1 Scholarships and Freeships Provided by the Institution

4	First Graduate Scholarship	Annual income of the Parents should be within Rs.1,00,000/- (Family members should not be a graduate)	State Government of Tamil Nadu
5	Pudhumaipenn Thittam (Moovalur Ramamirtham Ammaiyar) Scholarship	The applicant must be a citizen of India who is living in Tamil Nadu State. The applicant should have studied in Tamil medium from class 6 th to 12 th and must be a Girl student.	State Government of Tamil Nadu
6	Incentive for Tamil Medium Students	Graduate students who are studying in Tamil Medium	State Government of Tamil Nadu
