POLICY ON GREEN CAMPUS

Plastic pollution has become the world's biggest hazard now. Plastic usage has become a great threat to environment. The increase in plastic usage is the result of modernist way of thinking and living. As a result one time usage plastic things have become very common. And this has led to accumulation of plastics in large scale and plastic waste management has become a unsolvable crisis of the modern world. Measures taken:
