The Director of Council for College & Curriculum Development suggested the following changes in the regulations.

- 1) Value Added Course has to be subject/discipline oriented and related to the core subject.
- 2) It should be offered only for PG students.
- 3) A student can take up three Value Added Courses offered by the parent Department in I, II & III Semesters respectively.
- 4) Separate fees should not be collected for the course other than Examinations Fees.
- 5) Evaluation of the course has to be made similar to other regular courses.
- 6) A separate certificate need not to be issued. It should be indicated in the Mark statements and Cumulative Marks statement under Non-CGPA column.

- 1) Slow learners and Fast learners will have to be identified in the first year of the programmes and appropriate measures will have to be initiated.
- 2) The Academic council had suggested to do away with the outdated courses like DTP, Corel draw, Photoshop, etc. and offer contemporary courses like Web designing with PHP, etc. which will lead the students to

- Ph.D/Entrepreneurship/ Freelancership to enhance their employability skills.
- 3) Medical inspection of students should be conducted every year for first year students to identify congenital diseases and other fitness. Medical check-ups for staff should also be conducted.
- 4) There should be a provision to obtain vaccination details of students in the application form itself.
- 5) For science projects, medical related data can be obtained through local representation in Indian Medical Association.

## Suggestion of students:

- 1. Coaching for competitive examinations can be conducted every year.
- 2. In addition to Quantitative aptitude, test of reasoning may be made a part of the Curriculum and imparted as a Self Study Course.
