

## Minutes of the Governing Body Meeting

6/10/2015

The eighth Governing Body meeting of Government College For Women (Autonomous), Kumblaikunnam was held on 6/10/15 at 11:30 A.M in the Principal's room.

Dr. W. Jayaseeli Asst. Controller of Examinations welcomed the gathering. Dr. A. John Merina R.T.D., the State Government Nominee started the discussion on introducing new courses like Botany. Dr. Bernice Bennett Educationalist suggested that it would be better to have courses like Home Science, Nutrition & Dietetics since many Government colleges do not have such courses. Dr. P. Henra Latha, Controller of Examination in the discussion said that courses like B.B.A can be started since there is a great demand for it. Dr. S. Parthasarathy, University Nominee suggested that as there are courses like economics and Commerce, B.C.A can <sup>also</sup> be started. Dr. A. John Merina R.T.D., the State Government Nominee felt that technical courses like Visual Communication can also be started since it is a technological era.

Dr. S. Parthasarathy, University Nominee and Dr. Bernice Bennett, Educationalist referred many colleges which faces some practical difficulties in capitalizing. Dr. Bernice Bennett, Educationalist felt very worried on the poor strength of permanent staff. While discussing on the preparatory work of NAAC Dr. S. Parthasarathy University Nominee suggested that the only thing to be done immediately is documentation which will definitely speak on the day of facing NAAC. When there was a discussion on placement Dr. Bernice Bennett, Educationalist suggested that a new mail ID can be created separately making a slight change in the College Mail ID which will help in getting more information from the Alumni for placement. She further



enquired about the skill base subjects whether they are in common or major base and requested the senior staff members to share their opinion in bringing out new reforms in the college.

Dr. A. John Merina, R.T.D(I/c) State Government Nominee pointed out there are already 8 CCTV Cameras and again 16 more CCTV cameras are to be fixed very soon. It was suggested that it would be better if each department is provided one CCTV camera. Dr. S. Parthasarthy appreciated it and said that it will be really good. There was an elaborate discussion on Major and Minor Projects: Auto Grant for the year 2013-14 and 2014-15 was submitted. When there was a discussion regarding examination fund it was said that fifty lakhs was given to the self sufficient scheme. Every member of the board praised and were astonished by the co-ordination of the college.

Dr. Bernice Bennett was much worried about Part II English results and suggested that question patterns must be given to the students and train them up in such a way so that it will enhance their knowledge to face interviews. There was another discussion on having the same elective paper. It was suggested that it can be changed from batch to batch so that many elective papers can be introduced. There was a serious discussion on introducing new courses like Bio-technology, Bio-chemistry and Bio-informatics which is the need of the hour. Dr. K.S. Subramanyam, industrialist gave valuable suggestion about the maintenance of the existing campus. He spoke on rain water harvesting, water shed management and Solar system which the college has already implemented.

The members of the board were amazed by all the activities carried out in college and wished the college to get A Grade in NAA-C. Thus after a detailed discussion the meeting ended successfully. Mrs. C. Chennu Member Secretary proposed vote of thanks and recorded the minutes of the meeting.
