

## Minutes of the Governing Body Meeting

The ninth Governing Body Meeting of Government College for Women (Autonomous), Kumbhaksham was held on 16/09/16 at 10:00 A.M in the Principal's room.

Tmt. V. Lakshmi Principal in-charge welcomed the gathering. When the discussion started with the introduction of self study courses N.C.C. Nominee Dr. Mrs. Pankaj Mittal pointed out that it should be made clear that the self-study course is an add on course.

Dr. Bernice Bennett, Principal, Dharmapuri, suggested to include applied courses instead of having some traditional courses in the curriculum.

N.C.C. Nominee enquired on reason for getting B Grade and asked the member to find out the short comings of it and take the necessary steps to get A Grade. After a detailed discussion on it they came to know that one of the factor was lack of permanent faculty. The N.C.C. Nominee asked the principal to inform the Government to fill up the vacancies which will definitely improve the status of the college.

An elaborate discussion was done on the fee structure and evaluation pattern of the examination. N.C.C. Nominee insisted on conducting Orientation courses for faculties so that the students can acquire practical knowledge which is technology based. She pointed that students should be taken to villages to serve the society. This should be implemented in the curriculum by having a tie up with society. She also emphasised on an Action Taken Report in all subsequent report meetings.

Dr. K.S. Subramanyam M.A. Group of Company Industrialist suggested to contact the Small scale <sup>industry</sup> office of Thanjavur District and get the list of all small scale industries in and around Thanjavur District. The area of the interest of the Students should be identified and training must be given to them for employability.

NBC Nominee suggested to make use of the waste materials for Vermi composting, etc by converting into a bio-fertilizer which will be useful for the society. When the Tentative Budget was submitted a detailed summary of equipments should be included and it was further suggested that renovation and repairing to the existing buildings and equipments can be raised upto 50,000/-.

Dr. Bernie Bennett suggested to train the students to make paper bags and supply to shops in Kumbakonam and make Kumbakonam a plastic free town. She further insisted to motivate the faculties to update their knowledge by doing research. She also wanted to make the departments to conduct National Seminars jointly.

The NBC Nominee insisted that new programmes based on the requirements of area with employment viability should be started after proper survey and approval of the Governing Body. The representation of students shall be ensured while deciding on the issues like the equipments to be purchased, book/journals to be purchased/only subscribed and the updation of curriculum. In future the budget to be presented to the Governing Body should include the details of the expenditure proposed along with its justifications. Efforts should be made to ensure that the college contributes effectively for the development of society around it.
