POLICY ON PLASTIC BAN IN OUR COLLEGE

Plastic pollution has become the world's biggest hazard now. Plastic usage has become a great threat to environment. And this has led to accumulation of plastics in large scale and plastic waste management has become a unsolvable crisis of the modern world. Plastic usage is becoming a growing menace to environmental consciousness. It has proved to be a great danger to both the living and non-living organisms and to mother earth as well. Hence the college has developed a policy which helps in reducing and eliminating plastic pollution.

Measures taken:

3. The college organizes seminars and workshops in order to make students aware of the harmful impacts of plastic usage.

5. In order to avoid packed drinking water, water purifiers are kept for usage at important corners.
6. Usage of flex is minimize to a great level.
