1. INTRODUCTION

Examination wing of Government College for Women, Kumbakonam was established in the year 2006-2007 as a statutory body constituted in accordance with the UGC guidelines for autonomous colleges. The wing is headed by the Controller of Examinations (CoE), reporting to the Principal being the Chief Controller of Examinations and supported by the Deputy Controller and clerical staff. The primary responsibility of the Office of Examinations is to plan and conduct all examinations in a fair, transparent and systematic manner as per the academic Calendar prepared at the beginning of every academic year.

The examination procedures are in accordance with the guidelines of the Examination Manual which is in accordance with the Bharathidasan University and is in conformity with the UGC guidelines from time to time. The examination system has been fully automated with automation software systems and processes covering generation of question papers, registration for examinations, evaluation processes, preparation and publication of examination results, and printing of consolidated mark sheets.

The examination wing maintains a grievance redressal mechanism as a support to the students to deal with examination-related grievances. The office of examinations is committed to ensure efficient and effective functioning of its office for the benefit of the stake holders.

CIA mark statements were obtained from the departments. The tutors announce the CIA results to the students and submit it to the COE office. Students' signature was not obtained due to pandemic situation.

Conduct of end semester examination:

- Payment of Examination fees is made online through the Examination portal in the College website www.gcwk.ac.in making the process hassle free.
- The attendance eligibility for writing End Semester Examinations was altered due to the pandemic situation. The eligibility to write examinations were based upon submission of assignments, attending CIA tests online and payment of fees, instead of attendance eligibility due to pandemic situation.
- Examination timetable is generated through the COE software and is made available in the college website and also distributed to the departments.

- The End Semester Examinations of November 2020 and April 2021 was conducted online due to pandemic situation. The question papers were sent to students through mail from the COE office and the answer sheets were collected through mail to the respective course incharge staff. The students can also download the question paper from the College website on the day of examination.
- The students must send the soft copy of their answer sheets to the respective mail ids within the stipulated time.
