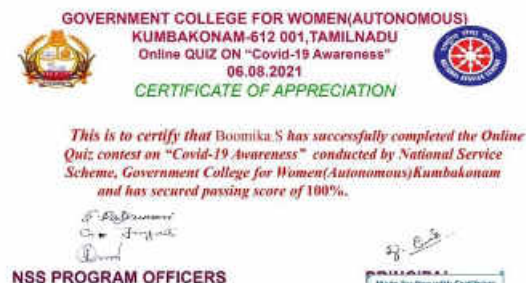
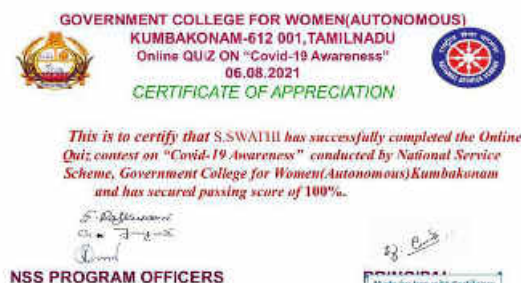


**GOVERNMENT COLLEGE FOR WOMEN(AUTONOMOUS), KUMBAKONAM**

**REGULAR ACTIVITIES -2021-2022**

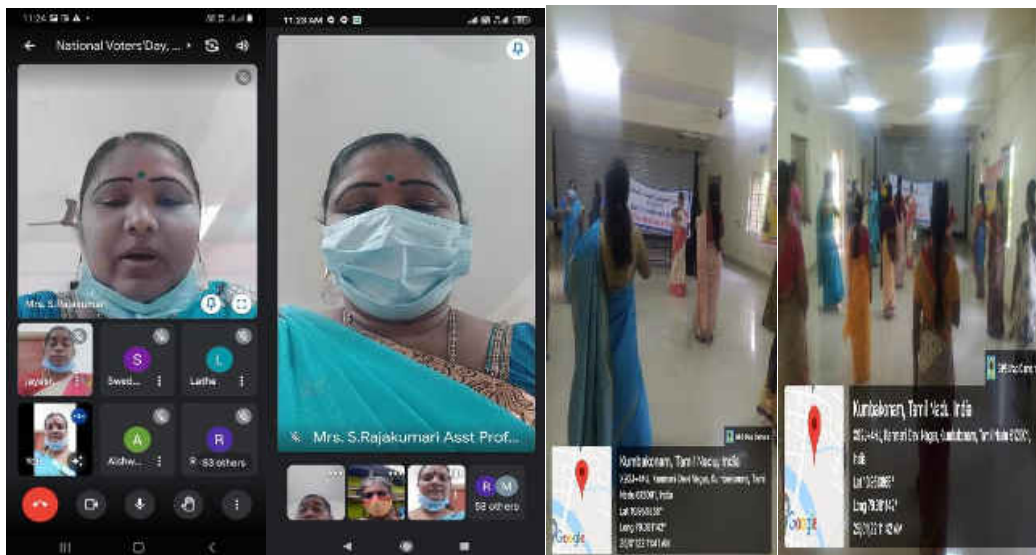
